

## Important to know

### Throughout the use of accua

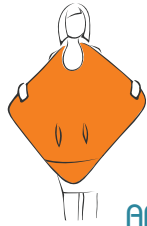
- accua is not meant to be used as sleepwear.
- Always use accua as instructed here to avoid incidents.
- Never leave your child unattended.
- Always follow your pediatrician's safety guidelines when bathing your child.

### About 3 months to sitting age

- The infant baby wrap phase is typically appropriate for babies under 3M of age. If your baby has outgrown the wrapping stage (usually around 3 months) and until he/she is able to stand, follow Infant steps 1-3 then proceed to Toddler steps D-F (while baby is lying on his/her back).

## Infant



APRON

- 1 Take accua with the hood facing **OUT** and secure collar around your neck using the Velcro tabs.

Enjoy bathing your baby!



TOWEL

- 2 While always maintaining a hold on your baby, slip your free hand through the slit on the same side, then slip your other hand through the other slit and pick up your baby. **Always hold your baby.**

- 3 Once your baby is on your chest, remove one hand from the slit while still holding him/her with the other hand. Place hood over your baby's head. Remove the other hand from slit and cover your baby with both sides of accua. Proceed to the changing area and place your infant on a flat surface.



BABYWRAP

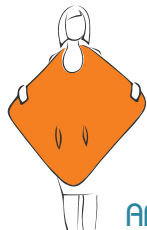
- 4 Release accua from around your neck while bending forward to keep your baby covered. If desired, wrap your baby with accua following steps F, G and H. accua is meant to be used as a "babywrap" **only for a short period of time** (for example, while you prepare your baby's clothes).

- 5 Place your baby's arms along his/her side and bring the right part of accua across your infant's belly and arm. Tuck it under his/her opposite torso. The hood can remain on your baby's head to keep him/her warm.

- 6 Wrap left wing across your baby's body, all the way around him/her until behind his/her neck with you run out of fabric. It is important to pull the fabric **snug but not tight**. When wrapping your baby, keep the fabric under baby's chin.

- 7 Finally, bring the circular opening up across your baby's body to attach behind his/her neck with Velcro tabs and form a comfortable collar: it is recommended to leave at least 1" between collar fabric and baby's neck. **If your child seems unusually fussy when wrapped, remove accua and dress him/her right away.**

## Toddler



APRON

- A Take accua with the hood facing **IN** and secure collar around your neck using the Velcro tabs.

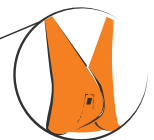
Enjoy bathing your child!



TOWEL

- B When ready to take your child out of the tub, help him/her stand and put the hood on his/her head.

- C Detach accua from around your neck and pick up your child with accua wrapped around him/her. Have your child stand on the bathroom mat and continue to dry him/her.



BATHWRAP

- D To help your child wear accua as a bathrobe, place each arm through the respective slits.

- E Close the front snaps and match same color Velcro tabs on top of each other. In the same way attach the tabs located on the circular opening.

- F Finally, bring the attached circular opening tabs forward, under and between your child's legs. Affix them to the Velcro tabs in front (from underneath).

**Ensure that Velcro tabs are properly attached to prevent tripping.**
